## CITY OF COLUSA

## Affidavit of Gross Receipts and Schedule of Business License Fees

Section 36 of City of Colusa Ordinance No. 252, provides that "every person conducting, managing or carrying on at a fixed place of business, trade or calling, whether as a merchant or otherwise, not otherwise specifically licensed by other section of this ordinance, shall pay a license tax for revenue purpose only unless otherwise specified, the amount of which shall be fixed and based upon the average monthly gross receipts of such business, trade or calling during the preceding twelve month period as follows:

**ORDINANCE NO. 252** of the City of Colusa provides that every merchant carrying on business in the City of Colusa, where the amount of the license is based upon the amount of receipts or sales effected or business transacted, is required to state under oath the amount of business which he transacted in the year preceding the commencement of the year for which the license is asked, and thereupon must procure a license from the City Clerk.

## **NOTICE**

**<u>DELINQUENCY</u>**- Ordinance 252 provides that a penalty of ten percent shall be added to the amount of any license tax if said tax remains unpaid for 30 days after the same is due. An additional penalty of 10 percent shall attach to and be added for each additional 30 days, or fraction thereof, from and after the 30-day period during which the license remains unpaid.

<u>PENALTY</u>- Ordinance No. 252 also provides that "any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance or knowingly or intentionally misrepresenting to any officer or employee of this City any material fact material fact in procuring the license here in provided for shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the City or County jail for a period of not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment."
