Motion passed 3-0 by the following roll-call vote:

8. <u>Subject:</u> Consideration of a Fee Moratorium on Building and Plan Check Fees for the City of Colusa's Downtown and Fremont Street for one (1) year.

DISCUSSION: City Manager Cain reported Fremont Street businesses were interested in the Fee Moratorium for store-front businesses and requested including Fremont Street between 5<sup>th</sup> Street and 9<sup>th</sup> Street to the agreement.

ACTION: Mayor Hill made a motion, seconded by Council Member Vaca to adopt **Resolution 21-36** with an amendment (from one year to eight months) approving a Moratorium on Building and Plan Check Fees for the Downtown Area and Fremont Business District for <u>eight months</u>. Motion passed 3-0 by the following roll-call vote:
