

The City of Colusa is able to provide this program through a grant from the boating safety nonprofit, the Sea Tow Foundation.





Each user who borrows a life jacket is obligated to inspect the life jacket prior to use and to return it clean and in good working order for the next user. These life jackets are not inspected or maintained after each use. Lifejackerts are borrowed at your own risk
