Serving on a local commission offers residents a unique opportunity to actively engage in shaping the community they live in.

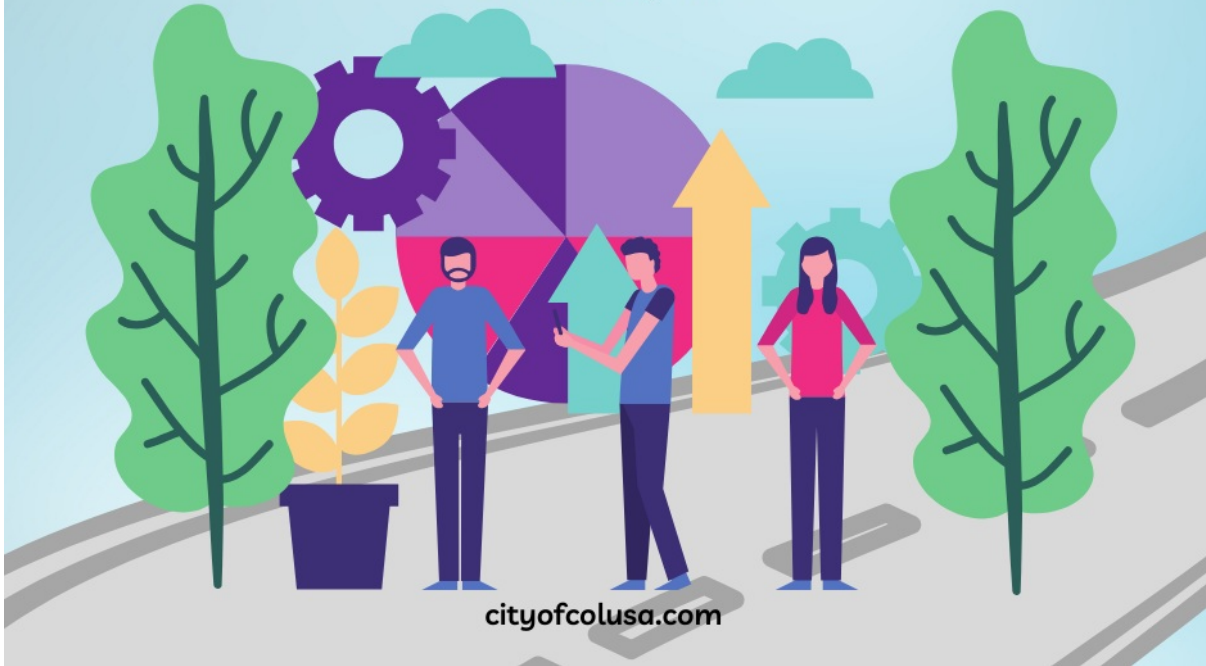
There are several seats available for our Planning, PRT, and Heritage Preservation Commissions:

Before you venture out to see all of the quilts, stop by the City of Colusa Fire Department for a Pancake Breakfast!

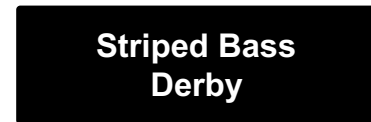
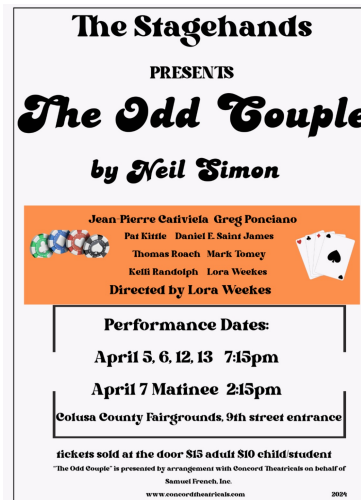
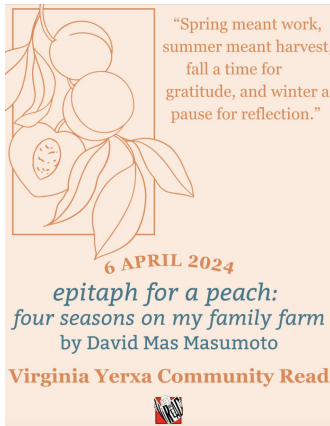
