# CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING MINUTES May 18, 2021

The virtual meeting was held via Zoom in accordance with Governor Newsom's Executive Order N25-20 and Executive Order N-29-20

**CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL** - Mayor Hill called the meeting to order at 6:06 pm. Present: Council Members Ponciano, Reische, Conrado, Vaca and Hill.

#### **COUNCIL CONSIDERATION**

9. Subject: Request to hire a Firefighter position.

DISCUSSION: Fire Chief Conley reported five of the volunteer Firefighters were leaving to work for CalFire. Conley explained the need for additional staff and discussed each of the three options.

ACTION: Council Member Vaca made a motion, seconded by Council Member Reische to continue this item to the next council meeting to allow staff time to research and provide answers to council's questions. Motion passed 5-0 by the following roll-call vote:

10. Subject: Consideration of Colusa Rebranding

DISCUSSION: City Manager Cain discussed rebranding the city logo. Council provided their input.

ACTION: Council Member Reische made a motion, seconded by Council Member Conrado providing staff permission to launch a rebranding effort. Motion passed 4-1 by the following roll-call vote:

11. Subject: Resolution for CDBG Application Submission

DISCUSSION: City Manager Cain explained the resolution requirement for submitting the CDBG application.

ACTION: Council Member Reische made a motion, seconded by Council Member Vaca to adopt **Resolution 21-33** approving the application for funding and the execution of a grant agreement and any amendments thereto from the 2020-2021 Funding Year of the State CDBG Program. Motion passed 5-0 by the following roll-call vote:

12. Subject: Council Appointments

DISCUSSION: City Manager Cain stated this was brought back to formalize the liaisons. Cain stated Ed Hulbert would have a meeting next week with the two liaisons.

ACTION: Council Members Ponciano and Conrado were appointed to be Colusa Industrial Properties (CIP) liaisons and Council Member Ponciano was appointed to the Colusa County Partnership One Stop Committee.
