

STRFFT TRFF PLANTING

- Individual property owners may apply to have a street tree planted by the City in the public right-of-way adjacent to their property for a \$25 fee per tree. Here are the steps to choosing and planting your street tree. *This fee may be waived during Trees for Tomorrow partnership with Colusa Rotary Club
- Review the City of Colusa Master Tree list and pick out a tree (see cityofcolusa.com/trees) Clicking on
 any tree on the Tree List will bring up a photo of the tree, size, canopy, suitable locations, etc..
- Pick a suitable location for street tree planting and creation of a tree basin. Locations within 3' of utilities, driveways, crosswalks, etc., within 5' feet of a fire hydrant, blocks any roadway signage, or locations that already have a tree or other plantings may be rejected. *Don't forget to Call 811 before you diq!*
- Complete the Street Tree Planting Application and drop it off or mail it to: City of Colusa, 425 Webster Street, Colusa, CA 95932. Alternatively, you may complete the form online and "save as" using your address as the file name (e.g., "123 Main Street), and then email it as an attachment to citymanager@cityofcolusa.com.
- The City will review your application and respond within two weeks. Trees will be planted during the
 proper season (usually spring or fall) and when City maintenance schedules allow. Once your tree is
 scheduled for planting, drop off or mail your check for \$25, payable to City of Colusa, tree planting in
 the memo line, to City of Colusa, 425 Webster Street, Colusa, CA 95932. Work will not begin without
 payment received.
- Once your tree is planted, you agree to water it accordingly and to keep the tree basin free of weeds and well mulched. Requests for training, pruning, or re-staking young trees may be done by contacting the City Manager, citymanager@cityofcolusa.com or leaving a message at (530) 458-4941 Ext. 105.
- You agree to adhere to the liability issues with trees (Colusa Municipal Code 19: Trees), which states: "Individuals may cut, trim, prune, remove, or spray trees or shrubs in City rights-of-way or alleys provided they obtain City approval by the Tree Commission or Public Works Administrator/Director. Property owners may trim or prune trees located in the rights-of-way immediately in front of and adjacent to their owned property without City approval provided that the trimming or pruning is done by a certified and licensed arborist in accordance with professionally recognized procedures and standards.
