Who Can Borrow A Life Jacket?

Anyone who needs one to go out on the water



How Much Will it Cost Me?

Nothing! We want to create an opportunity for everyone to be safe on the water.



Do You Have A Life Jacket For My Child?

We have life jackets available in sizes ranging from infant to adult



How Long Can I Keep It?

This program is for those who need a life jacket for a day or the weekend.

Where Do I Go To Borrow A Life Jacket?

Life jackets are available at the Colusa Fire Department
750 Market Street



The City of Colusa is able to provide this program through a grant from the boating safety nonprofit, the Sea Tow Foundation.



Life jackets are provided for the community. Each user who borrows a life jacket is obligated to inspect the life jacket prior to use and to return it clean and in good working order for the next user. These life jackets are not inspected or maintained after each use. Lifejackets are borrowed at your own risk

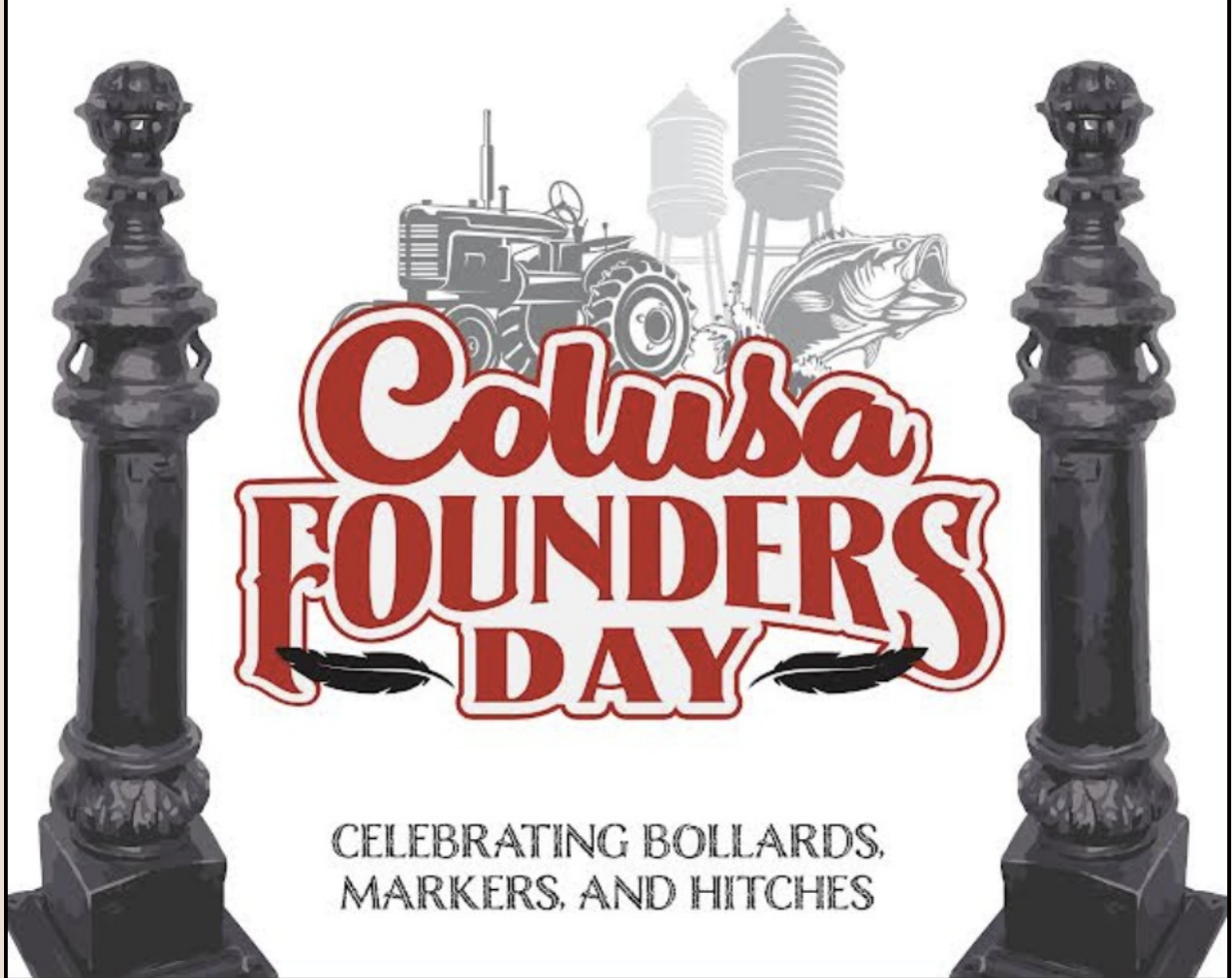
