## IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

In June 2025, the City of Colusa held a series of City Council and commission meetings focused on infrastructure, public safety, economic development, and heritage preservation.

The City Council convened for regular meetings on June 3 and June 17. At the June 3 meeting, the Council approved updates to the City's comprehensive fee schedule for FY 2025–26 and authorized a \$1.2 million contract with VSS International for citywide street maintenance using Measure B, LTF, and gas tax funds. The Council also approved submission of a federal Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant application and adopted updates to the City's purchasing policy. Additionally, the Council discussed policies regarding city-sponsored events and community donations. At the June 17 meeting, the Council approved the Local Hazard Mitigation Plan, entered into a professional services agreement with Endemic Architecture for preliminary police facility design, and adopted the FY 2025–26 City Budget along with the GANN appropriations limit. A lease agreement with the County Office of Education for records storage was also approved.

On June 18, a special City Council workshop was held to focus exclusively on economic development strategy. Topics included shaping Colusa's brand identity, improving visitor-based revenue, enhancing weekend tourism appeal, addressing commercial blight, and refining strategies for supporting and recruiting local businesses. The workshop served as a proactive step toward revitalizing the City's economic landscape.

Commission activity in June included a Planning Commission meeting on June 4 and a Heritage Preservation Commission meeting on June 10. The Planning Commission met at the County's office space to address standard agenda items related to development and land use. The Heritage Preservation Commission met at City Hall to review matters relevant to Colusa's historic assets and preservation efforts.

Overall, June 2025 was marked by key decisions and planning sessions that laid the groundwork for infrastructure investment, fiscal management, economic revitalization, and the preservation of Colusa's historic character.



The City of Colusa has begun Phase 2 of its RAC (Recycled Asphalt Concrete) road improvement project, continuing efforts to enhance road safety, durability, and sustainability throughout city neighborhoods. This phase includes resurfacing select streets using environmentally friendly recycled materials that reduce waste and improve long-term pavement performance. Funded in part by CalRecycle, the project reflects the City's commitment to smart infrastructure investments that benefit both residents and the environment. Construction is scheduled to begin 7/10 and includes Fremont Street. Full Detail will be available on the City website and Social Media accounts on July 8th.
