IN CASE YOU MISSED IT

In July, the City of Colusa held just one City Council meeting, on July 15. While the details of that agenda were routine in nature, the Council later confirmed the business of the month by approving those minutes at the following session. This midsummer meeting marked a relatively quiet period for city government, serving mainly to keep up with reports, approvals, and ongoing administrative business while laying the groundwork for the busier weeks that would follow.

August, by contrast, was an active month for the Council. At its August 5 meeting, the Council addressed financial housekeeping by approving departmental and financial reports, moving delinquent solid waste accounts to the tax roll, and updating the city's records retention policies. The evening also included public hearings for several assessment districts to ensure funding for neighborhood services and improvements, as well as a response to the Grand Jury's findings. Looking to the future, the Council discussed tree health in town and took steps to re-launch a community Taco Festival in Spring of 2026.

Two weeks later, on August 19, the Council returned with an agenda that mixed community celebration and long-term planning. Members approved a street closure for a lively Main Street dance, expanded the Measure B Citizens Oversight Committee to give more residents a role in fiscal accountability, and finalized utility easements needed for the upcoming detention and treatment facility project. The very next evening, on August 20, a special meeting was held to hear an appeal regarding a minor use permit for Colusa Meat, an animal processing facility proposed on Industrial Way. After testimony and deliberation, the Council denied the appeal and upheld the permit, marking a decisive end to a concentrated period of city business.
