**DEADLINES FOR SUBMISSION OF DIRECT ARGUMENTS AND REBUTTALS
GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION – NOVEMBER 3, 2026**

By its Resolution No. 26-38, the City Council of the City of Colusa submitted an ordinance to the voters for their consideration at the November 3, 2026, Municipal General Election. The question to be presented to the voters is:

To fund general city services, such as providing police/fire/emergency medical services and improving the City of Colusa's streets, parks and other infrastructure, shall an ordinance extending the existing a one-cent transactions and use tax (commonly referred to as the local sales tax) for an additional ten years be adopted, providing approximately \$1.25 million annually, with all funds locally controlled, a citizen's oversight committee and subject to annual audits? The City Clerk has fixed **Monday, August 10, 2026, 5:00 p.m.**, as the deadline for submitting to the Office of the City Clerk direct arguments for or against this measure. Reference is made to Elections Code Sec. 9280 *et seq.* for the requirements governing such arguments and the use thereof. Direct arguments may not exceed 300 words.

Rebuttal arguments will be accepted pursuant to Elections Code Sec. 9285. City Clerk has fixed **Thursday, August 20, 2026 at 5:00 p.m.** as the deadline for submitting rebuttals to the Office of the City Clerk. Rebuttals may not exceed 250 words.

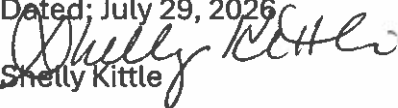
